John Boyne - The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas

One of the saddest books. Set during the time of the Holocaust. Saying anything else will ruin it. Read it!

Elizabeth Laird - Oranges in No Man's Land

Since her mother died, ten year old Ayesha has been living in the bomb- ravaged city of Beirut. When her Gran falls desperately ill she sets off on a terrifying journey to reach a doctor.

Anne Frank - Diary of Anne Frank

Stunning story of bravery during World War Two. Essential reading.

Terry Pratchett - Johnny and the Bomb

Time travel with a difference. Considered the best in the 'Johnny Maxwell series'. Can be read as a stand-alone novel.

Judith Kerr - When Hitler Stole Pink Rabbit

A modern classic. Anna only knows she's Jewish because her father says so. The story of how a family flees Berlin in 1933 due to the rise of the Nazis. One of the best books written about the war.

Ann Jungman - Resistance

Set in Holland during World War 2, Elli and Jan's parents are collaborators and the two children are given a hard time at school. Secretly they begin to help the Resistance.

Roald Dahl - Going Solo
